HANDLING AND STORAGE

Shelf life: Nominally 6 months. The product evolves a significant amount of ammonia gas which results in a progressive reduction in strength. The strength should be tested after the shelf life period to confirm suitability for use.

Storage Conditions: In upright, sealed containers in a cool well ventilated place, out of direct sunlight, ideally in a warehouse. Store below 25 °C. Store away from heat and sources of ignition.

Road tankers, according to transport regulations.
200 litre polythene drums and 1000 litre intermediate bulk containers (IBCs).

As a convenient source of ammonia used in a wide range of industries.
As a fertiliser.
As a nutrient in fermentation processes.
