STORAGE AND HANDLING

Being non-corrosive, the product can be stored in mild steel or aluminium containers, as well as in any type of storage used for fluid fertilisers. As with all other fertilizer solutions, it should not be allowed to contact with tin, copper, brass or other alloys.
